Property Editor

Define your own shape properties using the Property Editor. Define the name, type and visibility and simply assign the property to the corresponding shape using drag & drop.



Function list

The function list contains all the functions on the drawing. Sort, filter and group the list according to your requirements. You can extend the list with properties as required. The feature is completed by importing and exporting from Microsoft Excel.



Quick Shapes
